In Literacy we will be:

- All children in Primary 1 will be receiving a healthy break each day at the small weekly cost of £2, which should be placed in your child's individual snack wallet every
 Monday morning.
- Children are only allowed to drink water. They can leave their labelled water bottles in school and re-fill it each day using the water machine just outside our classroom.

- Listening out for sounds in our environment
- Learning some initial sounds –
 s, a, t, p, i, n.
