School Dinners

From Friday 1st September, the school meal service will provide a cooked lunch for pupils on free school meals and those who wish to purchase a meal.

The cost of the school meal is £2.50 per day for Nursery. £2.60 for primary pupils. Money must be paid on Monday mornings and the exact amount must be put into a sealed envelope. Change cannot be given.

Children should bring a packed lunch on Tuesday 29th August and Wednesday 30th August and Thursday 31st August (School is closed for the bank holiday on Monday 28th August) The school dinner service begins on Friday 1st September. (Nursery dinners will begin after Halloween)
