CHORUS

The Chase

GROUP 1: WIDOW TWANKEY, WISHY, WASHY

Find a way to disappear before they catch us up!
(Repeat)

GROUP 2: ABANAZAR and GUARDS

- 2 Mustn't let them get away, get away, get away,
Find the lamp without delay, got to keep up!
(Repeat)

GROUP 3: ALADDIN, JASMINE and KING

GROUP 1

(WT to audience)
